On June 9, 2010, as supplemented on June 15, 2010, ETC Tiger Pipeline, LLC ("ETC Tiger") filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") a request for a Level 3 variance to Sections IV.A.2 and IV.B.1 of its Upland Erosion Control, Revegetation, and Maintenance Plan. Specifically, ETC Tiger requested a variance for placing a barrier in lieu of topsoil to segregate the outer 20 feet of workspace in actively cultivated or rotated croplands, residential areas, hayfields, and other areas where the construction right-of-way ("ROW") parallels and overlaps the ROW of a foreign pipeline.

ETC Tiger hereby notifies the Commission that it no longer requires the above-referenced variance. In this regard, no Commission action is required in connection with ETC Tiger's June 9, 2010 and June 15, 2010 filings.
