Dear Ms. Bose:

On August 31, 2009 ETC Tiger Pipeline, LLC ("ETC Tiger"), filed an application under Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act, and Parts 157 and 284 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission" or "FERC") regulations, seeking authority to construct, own, and operate approximately 175 miles of 42-inch natural gas pipeline, and associated compression facilities and other appurtenant facilities (collectively, the "Tiger Pipeline" or "Tiger Project").

ETC Tiger is submitting for filing its Supplemental Environmental Information Report. This Report includes revisions to address the implications of other third-party facilities under construction along the proposed ETC Tiger Pipeline route and based upon site-specific conditions along the proposed pipeline. Furthermore, ETC Tiger is submitting as part of this filing, a Revised Exhibit G which is designated as Critical Energy Infrastructure Information ("CEII"), and an Updated List of Affected Landowners designated as Privileged Information. This Revised Exhibit G it is being re-filed to reflect the updated mile post ("MP") for the EnCana Marketing, Inc. receipt meter located at MP 64.6. Pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 702 effective December 14, 2007, and 18 CFR § 388.112 of the Commission's regulations, ETC Tiger has marked the contents of the CEII documents as **"Contains Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII) – Do Not Release"**, and the Privileged Information documents as **"Contains Privileged Information - Do Not Release."**
